An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Slidell to acquire a parcel of land from Standard Materials, LLC.

WHEREAS, Standard Materials, LLC, owns a parcel of land behind the former Hill-Behan building which parcel is bounded by Bayou Lane and Pennsylvania Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the property is ideal for expanding Heritage Park; and WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase the property; and

WHEREAS, Standard Materials, LLC, has agreed to sell the property to the City for the sum of Three Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$320,000.00) to be paid pursuant to a schedule to be determined at a later date; and

WHEREAS, the sales price equals or is less than the appraised value of the property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that its Mayor is hereby authorized to acquire the following described property for a sum not to exceed Three Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$320,000.00) payable according to the terms he deems suitable:
