ORDINANCE NO. 3104

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 27 Traffic and Vehicles, by adding a new section prohibiting the use of streamers, etc. during parades.

WHEREAS, in past parades streamers made of electrically conductive materials were shot into the air by some parade participants; and

WHEREAS, said streamers contacted overhead electric transmission lines causing shorts and power outages; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the shorts and outages, such streamers pose an electrocution hazard to parade participants, spectators, and the general public.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 27 Traffic and Vehicles, by adding a new Section 27-163 as follows:

"27-163. Streamers Prohibited.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to propel or cause to be propelled during a parade streamers and the like;
- (b) The term "streamers and the like" is defined as any flag, banner, pendant or strip of material which is or may be capable of conducting electric current and which is greater than two (2) feet in length;
 - (c) This section shall not apply to beads and other parade throws."
