7 An ordinance declaring certain property of the City of Slidell surplus and
8 setting the method of disposing same.

9 BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the property on the list
10 attached hereto and made a part hereof, is no longer needed by the City of Slidell for
11 public use and is hereby declared surplus and shall be sold to the highest bidder who
12 shall submit a sealed bid meeting specifications, or at a duly advertised public auction.

16 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the date, time, and place of sale are to
17 be fixed by the Mayor of Slidell, who shall also establish method of payment and other
18 specifications for bidders, including deadline for removal.

21 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that surplus Police Department vehicles
22 may be subject to sale by auction to other law enforcement agencies or political
23 subdivisions at a time, date and place determined by the Mayor or his designee who
24 shall also establish method of payment and other requirements for bidders including
25 deadline for removal.


