5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3161**

7 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell,
8 Chapter 23, Solid Waste, by setting the residential and commercial waste collection
9 times within the corporate limits of City of Slidell.

10 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has recently entered into a new contract for
11 residential garbage services; and

12
13 WHEREAS, the City is not involved in the specific contracts which garbage
14 companies have with businesses to pick up their commercial waste within its corporate
15 limits; and

16
17 WHEREAS, there have been on-going problems with commercial
18 dumpsters being serviced near residential areas at hours which are felt to be too early;
19 and

20
21 WHEREAS, the servicing of commercial dumpsters creates an excessive
22 amount of noise; and

23
24 WHEREAS, the City intends to ensure that its residents no longer
25 experience this audible disturbance while trying to sleep.



27 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it
28 does hereby amend its Code of Ordinances, Chapter 23 Solid Waste by adding a new
29 Section 23-10 as follows:

4 **“Sec. 23-10. Hours of Collection.**

5 Collection of residential refuse shall not commence before 6:00 o'clock
6
7 a.m., and shall be completed by 8:00 o'clock p.m. on any single collection day. Emptied
8
9 garbage cans, recycle bins and uncollected material exceeding collection standards
10
11 shall be removed from the street right-of-way by noon on the day following that day on
12
13 which the collection vehicle has completed collections in the particular geographical
14
15 collection area. Failure to remove the garbage can, recycle bin or other material by
16
17 noon on the day following collection shall be considered littering. The Slidell Police
18
19 Department and the Slidell Permits Department shall have the authority to enforce this
20
21 provision regarding hours for the removal of garbage cans, recycle bins, and other
22
23 materials for collection.

24 Collection of commercial refuse or commercial recyclables may not be
25
26 conducted where the dumpster or other commercial refuse container is within 200 feet
27
28 of any private residence between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Where the
29
30 dumpster or other commercial refuse container is more than 200 feet from residential
31
32 property, then the collection times stated above do not apply. For the purposes of this
33
34 provision, collection of commercial refuse or commercial recyclables at apartments,
35
36 apartment houses or complexes, condominium, and/or co-ops will be classified as
37
38 commercial collection.”
