ORDINANCE NO. 3172

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, Appendix A-Zoning, to provide for the placement of small satellite dishes in residential areas.

WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission has issued a favorable recommendation to amend Appendix A-Zoning to provide for the placement of small satellite dishes in residential areas.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, Appendix A-Zoning, Section 10.403 *Communications, television and radio antenna or towers and satellite dishes*, by adding a new paragraph (7) as follows:

"(7) Satellite antennas measuring four (4) feet or less in diameter may be attached to the main structure in the rear, side and front yard or may be free standing in the rear or side yard. No antenna may be attached to any tree."
