5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3180**

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8 An ordinance for the City of Slidell which shall set forth and designate the  
9 adjusted millage rates as required by Paragraph B of Section 23, Article VII of the  
10 Constitution of Louisiana, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Police  
11 Department, Garbage Collection, Sewer System, Public Works, General Government, as  
12 well as providing for the payment of interest and principal on outstanding general  
obligation bonds, in said City for the fiscal year 2005.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council of the City of  
14 Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied an aggregate tax  
15 of thirty-three and twenty hundredths (33.20) mills on the dollar upon all property taxable,  
16 under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in said City, according to the assessment  
17 roll of said City in the calendar year 2004.  
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20 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said aggregate tax is  
21 composed of the following individual authorized tax levys:  
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23 A tax of 6.18 mills for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenues to pay  
24 and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal and  
25 local purposes in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2005, as shown by the budget  
26 for the year 2005, adopted by the City Council of said City. So authorized by Louisiana  
27 Constitution Article VI, Section 27 at 6.18 mills.  
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29 A tax of 3.0 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal  
30 Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2005. So authorized by the  
31 special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1984.  
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4 A tax of 2.53 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal  
5 Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2005. So authorized by the  
6 special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.  
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9 A tax of 5.0 mills for the purpose of garbage disposal and maintenance in the City of  
10 Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2005. So authorized by the special taxpayer election held  
11 in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1994.  
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14 A tax of 5.0 mills for the purpose of maintenance of the sewerage system of the City  
15 of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2005. So authorized by the special taxpayer election held  
16 in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 8, 1994.  
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19 A tax of 2.46 mills for the purpose of maintaining, operating, and improving public  
20 works within the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2005. So authorized by the special  
21 taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.  
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24 A tax of 3.79 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest  
25 and maturing bonds for the 2004 General Obligation Refunding Bonds of the City of Slidell,  
26 Louisiana, for the year 2005, as authorized by a special election held November 8, 1988,  
27 and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Council Members of the City of Slidell,  
28 Louisiana, passed on the 9th day of March, 2004.  
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32 A tax of 5.24 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest  
33 and maturing bonds for the 1996 General Obligation Bonds for the City of Slidell,  
34 Louisiana, for the year 2005, as authorized by a special election held November 18, 1995,  
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
