ORDINANCE NO. 3226

An ordinance rezoning Parcels A, B and C located on the Northeast corner of West Hall Avenue and South Carnation Street from A-6 Single Family Residential to C-2 Neighborhood Commercial zoning designation, as petitioned by the Richard and Gina Brown.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council has received a petition from Richard and Gina Brown to rezone Parcels A, B and C located on the Northeast corner of West Hall Avenue and South Carnation Street from A-6 Single Family Residential to C-2 Neighborhood Commercial zoning designation; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission has issued a favorable recommendation for said annexation and zoning.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby rezone Parcels A, B and C located on the Northeast corner of West Hall Avenue and South Carnation Street from A-6 Single Family Residential to C-2 Neighborhood Commercial zoning designation and more fully described as follows:

These Parcels are more particularly described as: PARCEL A: All that certain Lot or Parcel of land, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being situated in the extreme southeast corner of Lot #2, Section 3, T-9-S, R-14-E, City of Slidell, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana. Said lot having a frontage of 70 feet on West Hall Avenue by a depth of 120 feet between equal and parallel lines and is more fully described as follows: Commencing at the southeast corner of the aforementioned Lot #2, which is common with the southwest corner of Lot #3 of Said Section 3, go thence North along the line between Lots #2 and #3 of Section 3 a distance of 120 feet; thence North 89 degrees 52' west 70 feet; thence south 120 feet to the northerly edge of West Hall Avenue; thence along West Hall Avenue being South 89 degrees 52' East 70 feet to the point of departure.

> PARCEL B: All that certain lot or parcel of land, with all buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being situated in the extreme southwest (SW) corner of Lot three (3), Section 3, T-9-S, R-14-E, Town of Slidell, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana. Said lot having a frontage of fifty-five (55) feet on West Hall Avenue by a depth of one hundred twenty (120) feet between equal and parallel lines and is more fully described as follows: Commencing at the Southwest (SW) corner of the aforementioned Lot 3, which is common with the Southeast (SE) corner of Lot 2 of said Section 3; go thence North along the line between lots 2 and 3 of said Section 3, a distance of one hundred twenty (120) feet; thence south 89 degrees, 52 minutes east 55 feet; thence south 120 feet to the northerly edge of West Hall Avenue; thence along West Hall Avenue north 89 degrees 52 minutes west fifty-five (55) feet to the point of departure.

> PARCEL C: All that certain lot or parcel of land, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being situated in Lot #3, Section 3, T-9-S, R-14-E, City of Slidell, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana. Said lot having a frontage of 50 feet on West Hall Avenue by a depth of 120 feet between equal and parallel lines and is more fully described as follows: From the southwest corner of Lot #3, which is common with the Southeast corner of Lot #2 of said Section 3, T-9-S, R-14-E, go south 89 degrees 52" East along the northerly edge of West Hall Avenue 55 feet to the point of beginning. Thence go north 120 feet; thence go south 89 degrees 52' East 50 feet; thence go South 120 feet to the northerly edge of West Hall Avenue; thence to along West Hall Avenue North 89 degrees 52' west 50 feet to the point of beginning.
