8 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, LA,
9 Chapter 4 Alcoholic Beverages, Sec. 4-29, to comport with distance measurement
10 procedures used in State law.

11 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
12 hereby amend Sec. 4-29 as follows:

13
14 **Sec. 4-29. Location restricted; exception.**

15
16 In paragraph (a) delete the following language:

17 "For businesses dealing in beverages of high alcoholic content, the measurement of
18 this distance shall be from the nearest point of the property line of a church or synagogue,
19 library, playground or school, to the nearest point of the property line of the premises to be
20 permitted. For businesses dealing in beverages of low alcohol content only, the
21 measurement of this distance shall be as a person walks using the sidewalk from the
22 nearest point of the property line of the church or synagogue, library, playground or school,
23 to the nearest point of the premises to be permitted."

29 Add the following language after the first sentence in paragraph (a):

31 "This distance shall be measured as a person walks using the sidewalk from the
32 nearest point of the property line of the church, synagogue, library, playground or school to
33 the nearest point of the premises to be permitted."


