ORDINANCE NO. 3242

An ordinance establishing a program of social welfare for the aid and support of the needy with Habitat for Humanity.

WHEREAS, Louisiana Constitution Article VII, Section 14 allows for the use of public funds for programs of social welfare for the aid and support of the needy; and

WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity provides for the construction of homes for people in need; and

WHEREAS, during the course of construction Habitat for Humanity at times requires certain assistance from the City of Slidell in order to complete construction; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell in order to provide assistance to Habitat for Humanity desires to establish a program of social welfare.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that a program of social welfare for the aid and support of the needy is hereby established in order to provide assistance to Habitat for Humanity for the construction of homes to people in need. Such assistance shall take the form of the waiver of fees for sewer and water connections to homes constructed by Habitat for Humanity, the donation to Habitat for Humanity of land owned by the City, or the provision of inmate labor for such construction. The provision of such assistance shall be at the discretion of the Mayor. The Mayor shall furnish such assistance upon terms and conditions he sees fit.
