ORDINANCE NO. 3262

An ordinance annexing and zoning 3.3 acres of land located on Hwy. 190 West (front portion of old Tiger Drive-In) from Parish C-2 Highway Commercial to City C-4 Highway Commercial zoning designation, as petitioned by Six G's, LLC.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council has received a petition from Six G's, LLC to annex and zone 3.3 acres of land located on Hwy. 190 West (front portion of old Tiger Drive-In) from Parish C-2 Highway Commercial to City C-4 Highway Commercial zoning designation; and

WHEREAS, said property is bounded by Highway 190 West, Camp Villere Rd., and Badon Road; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission has issued a <u>favorable</u> recommendation for said annexation and zoning with the following conditions:

- The City will require review of development proposals utilizing the applicable
 Parish Drainage Model and compliance with Parish Drainage Regulations.
- 2. The City of Slidell will require that a Traffic Impact Analysis be performed and the Parish Department of Engineering will be consulted on the traffic and access impacts of any proposed development.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the following described parcel of land be annexed into the corporate limits of the City of Slidell into Councilmanic District D and zoned City C-4 Highway Commercial, and more fully described as follows:

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Being situated in Section 5, T-9-S, R-14-E, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, being more fully described as follows: From the section comer common to Sections 37, 38 and 5 in said Township and Range, go North 11 degrees 36 minutes West 431.90 feet to the Northerly right of way line South 70 degrees 14 minutes East 94.30 feet to the East bank of a canal and the point of beginning.

Thence from the point of beginning go along said East bank of a canal being North 14 degrees, 29 minutes East 343.22 feet to a point; thence go East 306.00 feet to a point; thence go South 473.13 feet to the Northerly right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 190; thence go along said right-of-way line North 70 degrees, 14 Minutes West 416.38 feet bank to the point of beginning.
