ORDINANCE NO. 3268

An ordinance declaring certain property of the City of Slidell surplus and setting the method of disposing same.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the property on the list attached hereto and made a part hereof, is no longer needed by the City of Slidell for public use and is hereby declared surplus and shall be sold to the highest bidder who shall submit a sealed bid meeting specifications, or at a duly advertised public auction.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the date, time, and place of sale are to be fixed by the Mayor of Slidell, who shall also establish method of payment and other specifications for bidders, including deadline for removal.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that surplus Police Department vehicles may be subject to sale by auction to other law enforcement agencies or political subdivisions at a time, date and place determined by the Mayor or his designee who shall also establish method of payment and other requirements for bidders including deadline for removal.

This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.
