5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3272**

7 An ordinance for the City of Slidell which shall set forth and designate the
8 adjusted millage rates as required by Paragraph B of Section 23, Article VII of the
9 Constitution of Louisiana, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Police
10 Department, Garbage Collection, Sewer System, Public Works, General Government, as
11 well as providing for the payment of interest and principal on outstanding general
12 obligation bonds, in said City for the fiscal year 2006.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council of the City of
14 Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied an aggregate tax
15 of thirty and twenty-one hundredths (30.21) mills on the dollar upon all property taxable,
16 under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in said City, according to the assessment
17 roll of said City in the calendar year 2005.
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19 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said aggregate tax is
20 composed of the following individual authorized tax levys:

21 A tax of 5.72 mills for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenues to pay
22 and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal and
23 local purposes in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2006, as shown by the budget
24 for the year 2006, adopted by the City Council of said City. So authorized by Louisiana
25 Constitution Article VI, Section 27 at 5.72 mills.
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27 A tax of 2.78 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal
28 Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2006. So authorized by the
29 special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 2, 2004.
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4 A tax of 2.34 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal
5 Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2006. So authorized by the
6 special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.
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9 A tax of 4.63 mills for the purpose of garbage disposal and maintenance in the City
10 of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2006. So authorized by the special taxpayer election
11 held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 2, 2004.
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14 A tax of 4.63 mills for the purpose of maintenance of the sewerage system of the
15 City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2006. So authorized by the special taxpayer election
16 held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 2, 2004.
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19 A tax of 2.28 mills for the purpose of maintaining, operating, and improving public
20 works within the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2006. So authorized by the special
21 taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.
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24 A tax of 3.47 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest
25 and maturing bonds for the 2004 General Obligation Refunding Bonds of the City of Slidell,
26 Louisiana, for the year 2006, as authorized by a special election held November 8, 1988,
27 and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Council Members of the City of Slidell,
28 Louisiana, passed on the 9th day of March, 2004.
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31 A tax of 2.85 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest
32 and maturing bonds for the 1996 General Obligation Bonds for the City of Slidell,
33 Louisiana, for the year 2006, as authorized by a special election held November 18, 1995,
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4 and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Council Members of the City of Slidell,
5 Louisiana, passed on the 12th day of September, 1995.
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7 A tax of 1.51 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest
8 and maturing bonds for the 2005 General Obligation Refunding Bonds for the City of
9 Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2006, as authorized by a special election held November 18,
10 1995, and by a resolution of the Mayor and Council Members of the City of Slidell,
