5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3287**

7 An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 3184, revising the Revenue,
8 Expense and Capital Budget for fiscal year 2004/2005, providing for supplemental
9 appropriations, additional revenues, and matters in connection therewith.

10 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
11
12 hereby amend Ordinance No. 3184, revising the Revenue, Expense and Capital Budget
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14 for fiscal year 2004/2005, as attached herewith and made a part hereof.

15 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Slidell City Council does hereby
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17 establish personnel staffing and position classification levels for each department as
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19 presented in the Mayor's proposed budget booklet for fiscal year 2004-2005, adopted May
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21 27, 2004, and that the number of employees in each MSPG level shall be as therein stated
22
23 for each position, except that:

24 - the number of classified Administrative Secretaries (grade 6) in the
25
26 Department of Administration is decreased by one and the number of unclassified
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28 Administrative Secretaries in the Department of Administration (grade 46) is increased by
29
30 one; and

31 - the position of Water Treatment Technician in the Public Operations
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33 Department is changed from Grade 5 Non-Exempt to Grade 6 Non-Exempt; and

34 - the position of Pump Mechanic in the Public Operations Department is
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36 changed from Grade 5 Non-Exempt to Grade 6 Non-Exempt; and

37 - the position of Clerk of the Council (Grade 83) is changed to Council
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39 Administrator (Grade 84); and

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4 - the number of Electricians (Grade 6) in the Electrical Department is
5 decreased by one and the number of Sr. Electricians (Grade 10) is increased by one; and
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7 - the position of Property Maintenance inspector is changed from part-time
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9 to full-time (Grade 6); and

10 - those positions listed for upgrade in the proposed budget that were also a
11 part of the proposed pay plan will not be upgraded due to the lack of adoption of said pay
12 plan.
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15 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Council approval is required to amend,
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17 change, increase or reallocate any MSPG levels, or staffing except for Police Department
18 classifications for Police Officers, Corporals, and Sergeants, who shall have an automatic
19 promotion depending upon time in service and job performance.
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22 BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that each item listed in the attached shall
23 constitute a separate program, and substitutions thereto shall require Council approval.
