EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 3298

WHEREAS, Governor Blanco of the State of Louisiana has declared a Public Emergency in the entire State due to the devastation caused by Hurricane Katrina on August 29, 2005; and

WHEREAS, President Bush has also declared a federal emergency in the State of Louisiana due to the unprecedented devastation caused by Hurricane Katrina; and

WHEREAS, local officials, including St. Tammany Parish President Davis requested and concurred with this declaration of emergency; and

WHEREAS, a massive clean up of storm debris will be required in the City of Slidell; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has agreements for natural disaster clean ups with Gulf State Contractors and Omni Construction; and

WHEREAS, due to a total breakdown of all communication equipment, the City has not been able to contact Omni Construction, nor has Omni Construction presented themselves to the City of Slidell; and

WHEREAS, Gulf State Contractors and its subcontractors arrived at the City Operations Center on 8/31/05 with crews and equipment; and

WHEREAS, Paragraph L.2 of the general solid waste collection and disposal contract with Gulf State Contractors cannot be fairly invoked due to tremendous increases in gasoline prices, debris disposal prices, and dumping fees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council in legal session convened and under the authority of Section 2-13. Emergency Ordinances of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Slidell, that Mayor Ben O. Morris is hereby authorized to sign and enter into an emergency contract with Gulf State Contractors and its subcontractors as outlined in the attached contract for the purposes of storm debris cleanup and removal resulting from Hurricane Katrina.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance and the attached contract, due to the extreme emergency existing in the City of Slidell, shall be retroactive to September 1, 2005.
