21 to engage in cooperative endeavors for a public purpose; and
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
23 WHEREAS, the provision of housing for families in need has been

29 Agreement attached as Exhibit A.
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

COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT

This Agreement is being entered into by the City of Slidell ("City"), represented herein by its Mayor, Ben O. Morris, duly authorized by Ordinance Number 3320, and East Saint Tammany Habitat For Humanity ("Habitat"), represented herein by its Chairman, Property Committee, Jim Thomas.

WHEREAS, Louisiana Constitution Article 7, Section 14 authorizes the City to engage in cooperative endeavors for a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the provision of housing for families in need has been recognized as a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City and its citizens benefit when families in need have a home of their own; and

WHEREAS, the City owns a parcel of land at the intersection of Cleveland Avenue and Lincoln Avenue described as Lot, 8, Square 1, Innerarity Addition; and

WHEREAS, Habitat desires to construct housing on the land for families in need; and

WHEREAS, the City has not used the land and has no intentions to use it in the future; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to assist Habitat in its efforts by donating the land for the construction of the homes

THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN that the City does hereby donate unto East Saint Tammany Habitat For Humanity that certain parcel of property described as Lot 8, Square 1, Innerarity Addition, Slidell, Louisiana for the construction of housing for families in need; and
