Performs Administrative duties involving legal, financial and public relations matters and other related duties as assigned. Job duties are of a highly professional nature. Possesses a thorough knowledge of the laws and regulations controlling the office of the Mayor, to include municipal ordinances, state and federal laws and civil service rules and regulations. Serves as second in command in the absence of the Mayor and the Chief of

Staff. Minimum education: B.S. or B.A. required. Five years of progressively responsible experience in municipal government required. Masters level degree preferred."
