## **ORDINANCE NO. 3353**

An ordinance permitting the temporary placement of storage units at Lowe's for a period not to exceed 12 months.

WHEREAS, semi-trailers or cargo units can only be parked in commercial areas for a period not to exceed 90 days in a calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has received a request from Lowe's to extend to 12 months the period of time that semi-trailers or cargo units can be parked in a commercial area; and

WHEREAS, due to Hurricane Katrina, Lowe's has special order products for residents that are not normally stocked in its store; and

WHEREAS, Lowe's does not have the ability to store the amount of products demanded at this time.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby waive the provisions of appendix A Zoning, Section 2.1802 of the Code of Ordinances to permit the temporary placement of storage units at Lowe's for a maximum period of twelve (12) months.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall be in effect until October 26, 2007, at which time it shall no longer be effective.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that semi-trailers or cargo units are limited to one level; no stacking is permitted.

This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.
