ORDINANCE NO. 3358

An ordinance annexing and zoning 25.2 acres of land situated North of Highway 190 (Gause Blvd. West) adjacent to the Grand Theatre site on the east and zone the front 8.80 acres from Parish C-2 Highway Commercial to City C-4 Highway Commercial, and the rear 16.44 acres from Parish C-2 Highway Commercial to City A-8 High Density Urban, as petitioned by LICO of Slidell, Inc., represented by Intradel Corporation, its authorized agent.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council has received a petition from LICO of Slidell, Inc., represented by Intradel Corporation, its authorized agent, to annex 25.2 acres of land situated North of Highway 190 (Gause Blvd. West) adjacent to the Grand Theatre site on the east and zone the front 8.80 acres from Parish C-2 Highway Commercial to City C-4 Highway Commercial, and the rear 16.44 acres from Parish C-2 Highway Commercial to City A-8 High Density Urban; and

WHEREAS, this property will be resubdivided into two parcels as indicated on the attached survey after annexation is final; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission has issued a favorable recommendation for said annexation and zoning.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the following described parcel of land be annexed into the corporate limits of the City of Slidell into Councilmanic District D and zoned as follows:

Parcel 1 (8.80 acres) C-4 Highway Commercial

Parcel 2 (16.44 acres) A-8 High Density Urban and more fully described as follows:

Measure thence from the point of beginning S18°18'19"W a distance of 400.00 feet to a point on the northerly right of way line of U.S. Highway 190; thence along said northerly line N70°50'14"W a distance of 208.70 feet; thence along said northerly line N70°43'51"W a distance of 703.08 feet; thence N00°30'55"W a distance of 406.80 feet; thence S71 °41'41 "E a distance of 1042.89 feet to a point, the point of beginning.

Begin at the section corner common to Sections 4 and 5, Township 9 South, Range 14 East and Sections 32 and 33, Township 8 South, Range 14 East. Measure thence from the point of beginning S00°04'28'1 a distance of 725.10 feet; thence S70°34'04"E a distance of 129.52 feet; thence S18°18'19"W a distance of 120.72 feet; thence N71 °41'41"W a distance of 1042.89 feet; thence S00°30'55"E a distance of 406.80 feet to a point on the northerly right of way line of U.S. Highway 190; thence along said northerly line N70°43'51"W a distance of 69.08 feet; thence N0°30'55'W a distance of

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940.26 feet; thence S89°56'30"E a distance of 976.84 feet to a point on the section corner common to Sections 4 and 5, Township 9 South, Range 14 East and sections 32 and 33, Township 8 South, Range 14 East, the point of beginning.

Said Parcel 2 contains 16.44 acres.
