ORDINANCE NO. 3364

An ordinance amending the Beignet Station lease relative to subleasing, hours of operation and sublessor obligations.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3070, adopted by the Slidell City Council on June 11, 2002, authorized the City to enter into a cooperative endeavor in the form of a commercial lease between the City and Jenny Clement d/b/a The Beignet Station; and

WHEREAS, Clement has expressed the desire to sublease the premises; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the lease relative to hours of operation and further desires to specify the obligations of the lessor and any sublessor;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the lease between the City and Jenny Clement d/b/a The Beignet Station be amended as follows:

Paragraph 15 which specifies Hours Of Operation is deleted;

A new Paragraph 15 is added entitled "Sublease" which shall read: "Lessee shall have the right to sublease the premises to May-Bias, L.L.C. upon the same terms and conditions of this lease provided that lessee shall remain obligated to fulfill the terms of this lease in the case of default by sublessee and further provided that May-Bias, L.L.C. shall exercise the right to renew as provided in Paragraph 3 hereof. The exercising of the right to renew shall be in writing to the City within 15 days of the sublease."

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the sublessee, May-Bias, L.L.C., operate The Beignet Station according to the business plan submitted to the City and that the hours of operation contained therein shall be minimum hours of operation.
