ORDINANCE NO. 3367

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 7 Buildings and Building Regulations, relative to culvert requirements for residences damaged by Hurricane Katrina.

WHEREAS, Hurricane Katrina damaged many residences which will be demolished and rebuilt; and

WHEREAS, the current ordinance requires culverts to be installed in open ditches when a new house is built; and

WHEREAS, that requirement would place additional burdens on homeowners who are striving to recover from the storm.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 7 Buildings and Building Regulations, Section 7-208 to add a new subsection "(d)" to read as follows:

- Sec. 7-208. Drainage culverts required on unimproved lots with open ditches; submission of plans and specifications; inspection of work; violations declared misdemeanor.
- "(d) The requirements of subsection (a) shall not apply to lots upon which new houses are constructed to replace those houses damaged by Hurricane Katrina and were demolished due to hurricane damage."
