7 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell,
8 Chapter 7 Buildings and Building Regulations, relative to culvert requirements for
9 residences damaged by Hurricane Katrina.

11 WHEREAS, Hurricane Katrina damaged many residences which will be
12 demolished and rebuilt; and

13
14 WHEREAS, the current ordinance requires culverts to be installed in open
15 ditches when a new house is built; and

16
17 WHEREAS, that requirement would place additional burdens on
18 homeowners who are striving to recover from the storm.

19
20 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
21 hereby amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 7 Buildings and
22 Building Regulations, Section 7-208 to add a new subsection "(d)" to read as follows:


24 **Sec. 7-208. Drainage culverts required on unimproved lots with open ditches;
25 submission of plans and specifications; inspection of work;
26 violations declared misdemeanor.**

29 "(d) The requirements of subsection (a) shall not apply to lots upon which new
30 houses are constructed to replace those houses damaged by Hurricane Katrina and were
31 demolished due to hurricane damage."




