7 An ordinance declaring certain property of the City of Slidell surplus and
8 setting the method of disposing same.

10 BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the property on the list
11 attached hereto and made a part hereof, is no longer needed by the City of Slidell for
12 public use and is hereby declared surplus and shall be sold to the highest bidder who shall
13 submit a sealed bid meeting specifications, or at a duly advertised public auction.

16 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the date, time, and place of sale are to be
17 fixed by the Mayor of Slidell, who shall also establish method of payment and other
18 specifications for bidders, including deadline for removal.

21 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that surplus Police Department vehicles may
22 be subject to sale by auction to other law enforcement agencies or political subdivisions at
23 a time, date and place determined by the Mayor or his designee who shall also establish
24 method of payment and other requirements for bidders including deadline for removal.
