6 An ordinance relative to registration of privately-owned travel trailers and
7 recreational vehicles.

10 WHEREAS, on September 28, 2005, the Slidell City Council adopted
11 Ordinance No. 3301 that waived the prohibition against the placement of travel trailers and
12 recreational vehicles for occupancy in residential areas; and
13

15 WHEREAS, the waiver was intended to assist persons renovating their
16 homes after Hurricane Katrina; and
17

18 WHEREAS, the waiver was set to expire on September 28, 2006; and

19
20 WHEREAS, that expiration date was extended to March 28, 2007 by
21 Resolution R06-29; and
22

23 WHEREAS, Resolution R07-08 again extended the expiration date to
24 September 28, 2007; and
25

26 WHEREAS, the waiver is currently in force; and
27

28 WHEREAS, the Parish of St. Tammany has instituted a registration program
29 for persons who have FEMA supplied temporary housing; and
30

31 WHEREAS, the Parish's program does not encompass privately-owned
32 travel trailers or recreational vehicles; and
33

34 WHEREAS, the City desires to have a similar registration program that would
35 include such trailers and vehicles so that the City can determine the reasons and need for
36 such trailers and vehicles being still in place and receiving City water and sewer services.



4 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that all
5 privately-owned travel trailers and recreational vehicles that receive water and/or sewer
6 services from the City of Slidell shall be registered with the Slidell Planning Department.
7 Registrants shall use a form substantially similar to the one attached hereto.

10 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the Slidell
11 Planning Department shall determine whether the need and reasons as stated on the form
12 prescribed herein is sufficient to maintain the waiver established by Ordinance 3301. In
13 the event such need and reasons are deemed sufficient an approval shall be issued.

16 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that all travel trailers
17 and recreational vehicles not required to be registered and approved pursuant to this
18 Ordinance shall be subject to the provisions of Appendix A, Zoning, Section 4.104.
