ORDINANCE NO. 3398

An ordinance relative to registration of privately-owned travel trailers and recreational vehicles.

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2005, the Slidell City Council adopted Ordinance No. 3301 that waived the prohibition against the placement of travel trailers and recreational vehicles for occupancy in residential areas; and

WHEREAS, the waiver was intended to assist persons renovating their homes after Hurricane Katrina; and

WHEREAS, the waiver was set to expire on September 28, 2006; and

WHEREAS, that expiration date was extended to March 28, 2007 by Resolution R06-29; and

WHEREAS, Resolution R07-08 again extended the expiration date to September 28, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the waiver is currently in force; and

WHEREAS, the Parish of St. Tammany has instituted a registration program for persons who have FEMA supplied temporary housing; and

WHEREAS, the Parish's program does not encompass privately-owned travel trailers or recreational vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to have a similar registration program that would include such trailers and vehicles so that the City can determine the reasons and need for such trailers and vehicles being still in place and receiving City water and sewer services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that all privately-owned travel trailers and recreational vehicles that receive water and/or sewer services from the City of Slidell shall be registered with the Slidell Planning Department. Registrants shall use a form substantially similar to the one attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the Slidell Planning Department shall determine whether the need and reasons as stated on the form prescribed herein is sufficient to maintain the waiver established by Ordinance 3301. In the event such need and reasons are deemed sufficient an approval shall be issued.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that all travel trailers and recreational vehicles not required to be registered and approved pursuant to this Ordinance shall be subject to the provisions of Appendix A, Zoning, Section 4.104.
