6 **ORDINANCE NO. 3399**

7 An ordinance for the City of Slidell which shall set forth and designate the
8 adjusted millage rates as required by Paragraph B of Section 23, Article VII of the
9 Constitution of Louisiana, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Police
10 Department, Garbage Collection, Sewer System, Public Works, General Government, as
11 well as providing for the payment of interest and principal on outstanding general
12 obligation bonds, in said City for the fiscal year 2008.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council of the City of
14 Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied an aggregate tax
15 of thirty and ninety-eight hundredths (30.98) mills on the dollar upon all property taxable,
16 under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in said City, according to the assessment
17 roll of said City in the calendar year 2007.
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19 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said aggregate tax is
20 composed of the following individual authorized tax levys:
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22 A tax of 5.72 mills for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenues
23 to pay and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal
24 and local purposes in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2008, as shown by the
25 budget for the year 2008, adopted by the City Council of said City. So authorized by
26 Louisiana Constitution Article VI, Section 27 at 5.72 mills.
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28 A tax of 2.78 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the
29 Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2008. So
30 authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November
31 2, 2004.
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4 A tax of 2.34 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the
5 Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2008. So
6 authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4,
7
8 1981.

10 A tax of 4.63 mills for the purpose of garbage disposal and maintenance in
11 the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2008. So authorized by the special taxpayer
12 election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 2, 2004.
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15 A tax of 4.63 mills for the purpose of maintenance of the sewerage system of
16 the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2008. So authorized by the special taxpayer
17 election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, November 2, 2004.
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20 A tax of 2.28 mills for the purpose of maintaining, operating, and improving
21 public works within the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2008. So authorized by the
22 special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981.
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
25 A tax of 3.80 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay
26 interest and maturing bonds for the 2004 General Obligation Refunding Bonds of the City
27 of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 2008, as authorized by a special election held November
28 8, 1988, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Council Members of the City of Slidell,
29 Louisiana, passed on the 9th day of March, 2004.
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
33 A tax of 4.80 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay
