NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the trailer is no longer needed by the City of Slidell for public use and is hereby declared surplus and shall be sold to the highest bidder who shall submit a sealed bid meeting specifications, or at a duly advertised public auction, or if no bidders are found, donated.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the date, time and place of sale are to be fixed by the Mayor of Slidell, who shall also establish method of payment and other specifications for bidders, including deadline for removal.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that this ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.
