9 An ordinance establishing a drug and alcohol free zone along a designated
10 area of the Krewe of Selene parade route.

11 WHEREAS, the Mardi Gras Krewe of Selene will parade through the City of
12 Slidell (City) on February 1, 2008, and
13

14 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has received a request from Prevention With
15 Pride (Pride) to establish a drug and alcohol free zone (the Zone) along the parade route;

19 WHEREAS, the Bethany Lutheran Church has agreed to partner with Pride
20 and the City in establishing and maintaining the Zone during the parade; and
21

22 WHEREAS, establishment of the Zone will promote a family atmosphere to
23 enhance enjoyment of the parade.

26 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that a Drug
27 and Alcohol Free Zone is hereby established, the area of which is described as follows:
28

29 An area bounded by the northern right-of-way line of Gause Boulevard, the
30 western right-of-way line of 8th Street, the southern right-of-way line of
31 Louisiana Avenue and the eastern right-of-way line of 9th Street.

32 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the possession and/or use of any alcoholic
33 beverage or illegal drugs by any person shall be a misdemeanor and subject to the
34 penalties prescribed in Ordinance Section 1-12.

6 Zone.


7 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall not apply to persons

9 authorized to participate in the Selene parade.


10 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall be valid only during
