7 An ordinance by the Slidell City Council relative the Slidell Antique Fair.

8 WHEREAS, the Slidell Antique Association biannually hosts the Slidell
9
10 Antique Fair in Old Town; and

11
12 WHEREAS, the Fair is an asset to the Old Town area and to the City in
13 general; and

14
15 WHEREAS, the City desires to assist the Association with matters regarding
16 traffic controls and closure of certain streets and related matters; and

17
18 WHEREAS, the City is cognizant of the concerns of various businesses that
19 do not participate in the Fair but are located within the area of the Fair; and

20
21 WHEREAS, this ordinance strikes an equitable balance between the
22 interests of the Association and other businesses.

23
24 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that:

- 25
26 (1) The following streets shall be barricaded and closed to vehicular traffic from
27
28 6:00 o'clock p.m. on the day immediately preceding the first day of the Fair to
29
30 6:00 o'clock p.m. or until two hours after the conclusion of the Fair, at which
31 time all booths and fair related vehicles shall be removed from the streets.

33 First Street from Front Street to Bouscaren Street;

34
35 Second Street from Erlanger Street to Bouscaren Street;

36
37 Erlanger Street from First Street to Third Street;

38
39 Bouscaren Street from Front Street to Second Street.



4 (2) Vendors associated with the Fair shall be allowed to set up booths on the
5 closed streets in such a configuration determined by the Association and as
6 designated in the permit.

9 (3) The sidewalks adjacent to the closed streets shall remain open and available
10 to pedestrian traffic.
11


12 (4) Access to businesses along the closed streets from the sidewalks shall not be
13 impeded.


