ORDINANCE NO. 3542

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 21 Personnel, by adding a new section relative to automobile allowances.

WHEREAS, the City has given automobile allowances to certain employees and elected officials on a case-by-case basis; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to hereby define the parameters of the allowances.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend the Code of Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Chapter 21 Personnel, by adding a new section as follows:

"Sec. 21-26. Automobile Allowance.

- (a) Any employee or elected official who receives an automobile allowance from the City shall be responsible all operating expenses for a personal vehicle of their choosing including, but not limited to, maintenance, upkeep, insurance, fuel, repairs, tires, fluids, cleaning and every other cost associated with the operation of their personal vehicle.
- (b) The amount of the automobile allowance shall be no more than five hundred fifty (\$550.00) dollars per month.
- (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), employees or elected officials who receive an automobile allowance from the City and who travel in their personal vehicle for a distance in excess of fifty miles in a single trip while on City business

> may seek reimbursement for mileage in excess of fifty miles at the prevailing rate established by the Internal Revenue Service upon submission of documentation acceptable to the City's Department of Finance.
