6 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell,  
7 Appendix A Zoning, Section 2.23 Sign Regulation.

8 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council wishes to clarify certain language in sign  
9 ordinance; and

10 WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission has issued a  
11 favorable recommendation for said changes.

12 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does  
13 hereby amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Appendix A Zoning, as  
14 follows:

15 **Appendix A Zoning**  
16 **Section 2.23. Sign regulation.**

17 **502.27 Public Signs.**

18 Add the following at the end of the paragraph, "Public signs shall also include  
19 temporary signs advising of homeowner association meetings and meetings of civic  
20 organizations such as the Rotary Club, Lion's Club, Veterans of Foreign Wars and similar  
21 organizations as determined by the Department of Planning.


23 Add the following at the end of the first sentence "Public signs advising of  
24 homeowner association and civic organization meetings may be placed in the City right-  
25 of-way no sooner than seventy-two (72) hours prior to the meeting, and shall be removed  
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
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4 within twenty-four (24) hours subsequent to the meeting. Homeowner and civic  
5 associations shall obtain a no cost permit from the City for all such signs.
