ORDINANCE NO. 3553

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Slidell to execute a Lease Agreement with Christ Episcopal Church, for certain immovable property located at 1535 7th Street, Slidell, Louisiana.

WHEREAS, in March, 2009, the City of Slidell purchased the following described property in connection with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) flood mitigation program:

THAT CERTAIN PIECE OR PORTION OF GROUND, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon, and all the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, appurtenances and advantages thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, lying and being situated in the Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

ALL OF LOT 7 AND A PORTION OF LOT 8 IN SQUARE 26, BRUGIER ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF SLIDELL. Lot 7 has a front of 55 feet on Seventh Street, by a depth of 150 feet between parallel lines. The said portion of Lot 8 has a front of 55 feet on Seventh Street by a depth of 100 feet between parallel lines. Said Square 26 is bounded by Sixth Street, Michigan Ave., Seventh Street and Pennsylvania Avenue, all in accordance with the official map of said Town of Slidell, and in accordance with survey of Lamar P. Harrison, Surveyor, dated February 27, 1962.

THE IMPROVEMENTS THEREON BEAR THE MUNICIPAL NO. 1535 7th STREET, SLIDELL, LOUISIANA 70458.

WHEREAS, the City has no present use for this property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that all of Lot 7 and a portion of lot 8 in Square 26, Brugier Addition in the Town of shall be leased to the interested parties for the sum of ONE AND NO/100 DOLLAR per year for ten (10)

years beginning on December 1, 2009, for the express use as an overflow parking lot. The term of this lease is for ten (10) years with an option to renew for an additional ten (10) year period on the same terms and conditions.
