5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3557**

6 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell,
7 Chapter 1, General Provisions, Section 1-12, relative to general penalty provision.
8

9 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the
10 Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 1, General Provisions, is hereby
11 rescinded and reenacted to read as follows:
12

13 **"Sec. 1-12. General penalty.**

14 It shall be unlawful for any person to violate or fail to comply with the
15 provisions of this Code of Ordinances, and these shall be civil violations. Civil violators
16 shall be subject to civil penalties and civil fines up to, but not exceeding, one thousand
17 dollars (\$1,000.00) plus legislatively approved costs, expenses and legal interest from the
18 date of violation, at the Court's discretion, per violation. Each day any violation of, or failure
19 to comply with, any provision of this Code of Ordinances shall constitute a violation.
20

21 Any penalty heretofore adopted prior to the effective date of this Ordinance is
22 hereby repealed."
23

24 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Chapter 11, General Provisions, is hereby
25 rescinded and reenacted to read as follows:
26

27 **"Sec. 11-4. Penalties for violation of Chapter.**


28 It shall be unlawful for any person to violate or fail to comply with any
29 provision of this Chapter. The violation of, or failure to comply with, any provision of this
30 Chapter shall be punished by a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or




4 imprisonment for a term not exceeding six (6) months, or both by such fine and
5 imprisonment, within the discretion of the Court, together with all legislatively allowed
6 costs.


