EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 3573

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to acquire the necessary property for the construction of the Southwest Frontage Road in connection with the Summit Fremaux Development.

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2010, the City of Slidell learned of the possibility of Federal Stimulus funds being available through St. Tammany Parish which could be used for the acquisition of the necessary parcels of land (hereinafter referred to as "Property") and the construction of the Southwest Frontage Road in connection with the Summit Fremaux Development; and

WHEREAS, the City was given a deadline of May 19, 2010, within which all requirements of the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development as well as those of the Federal Highway Agency; and

WHEREAS, the said deadline has been extended to May 28, 2010; and

WHEREAS, should the deadline pass without all requirements having been met, the likelihood of the removal of the Stimulus funds for the purpose of the Southwest Frontage Road is great; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council considers the great likelihood of losing the Stimulus funds to be a public emergency affecting property under the provisions of Home Rule Charter Section 2-13; and

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WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council desires to authorize the Mayor to purchase, expropriate or otherwise acquire the necessary Property for the construction of the Southwest Frontage Road.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to do whatever is necessary to acquire the Property described in Exhibit A attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that, if purchased, the price shall not exceed the fair market value of the Property as evidenced by an appraisal or appraisals obtained by or supplied to the City plus fees and costs.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all actions previously taken by the Mayor or his designee in furtherance of the actions authorized herein are hereby ratified and accepted accordingly.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to by severable.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.




