10 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the
11 property on the Supplemental Surplus FY10 list dated 5/5/10, attached hereto and made a
12 part hereof, is no longer needed by the City of Slidell for public use and is hereby declared
13 surplus and shall be sold to the highest bidder who shall submit a sealed bid meeting
14 specifications, or at a duly advertised public auction.
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18 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the date, time, and place of sale are to be
19 fixed by the Mayor of Slidell, who shall also establish method of payment and other
20 specifications for bidders, including deadline for removal.
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
23 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that surplus Police Department vehicles may
24 be subject to sale by auction to other law enforcement agencies or political subdivisions at
25 a time, date and place determined by the Mayor or his designee who shall also establish

30 adoption.
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
