5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3585**

6 An ordinance rescinding and re-enacting Chapter 22 Planning, Sec. 22-30 of
7 the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, relative to voting requirements to transact
8 business.
9

10 WHEREAS, Section 22-30 regarding the transaction of business by the City's
11 Planning and Zoning Commissions requires a majority vote of the authorized membership
12 of the commission in order to adopt all motions, resolutions and all other official actions;

16 WHEREAS, each Commission is comprised of seven members; and
17

18 WHEREAS, in order to comply with Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell,
19 Chapter 22, Section 22-30 a vote of four members is required for the Commissions to
20 transact all business; and
21

22 WHEREAS, in the event of a minimum quorum of four members attending a
23 meeting a unanimous vote would therefore be required to transact business; and
24

25 WHEREAS, such a requirement operates as a hindrance to the transaction
26 of Commission business; and
27

28 WHEREAS, the Slidell Board of Zoning Adjustment transacts business by a
29 majority vote of the members present and voting at a meeting;


31 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the


