## **ORDINANCE NO. 3586**

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell Chapter 2 Administration, Section 2-186 relative to residency requirements for certain boards and commissions.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 2 Administration, Article IV. – Boards and Commissions, Division 1. – Generally, Section 2-186. Residency requirements for certain boards and commissions, is hereby rescinded and reenacted to read as follows:

## "Sec. 2-186. Residency requirements for certain boards and commissions.

- (a) All members of the board of adjustment, and the planning and zoning commissions shall reside within the city limits at the time of their appointment and shall continue to reside within the city limits throughout their term of office.
- (b) Any member of such boards and commissions who relocates his residence to an area outside the city limits during his term of office shall resign his seat or have it declared vacant by the property authority.
- (c) All members of the board of directors of the Slidell Housing Authority shall reside within the 8th or 9th Wards of St. Tammany Parish throughout their terms of office.
- (d) All members of the Slidell Housing Authority board of directors who relocates his residence outside the 8th or 9th Wards of St. Tammany Parish during his term of office shall resign his seat or have it declared vacant by the property authority.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
