6 **ORDINANCE NO. 3609**

8 An ordinance by the Slidell City Council declaring that a reapportionment of
9 the election district boundaries commence to rebalance district populations as a result of
10 the 2010 Census.

11 WHEREAS, the Census 2010 count has been completed and the PL 94-171
12 reapportionment data was delivered to the State of Louisiana on the 7th of February,
13 2010; and
14

15 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council, under LA RS: 33:1411 must make a
16 determination whether reapportionment is necessary with the Census 2010 population
17 count no later than the 7th of August, 2010, and
18

19 WHEREAS, the Council commissioned a study to calculate the new Census
20 2010 population in each of the existing elections districts, and

22 WHEREAS, the current districts have the following Census 2010 population

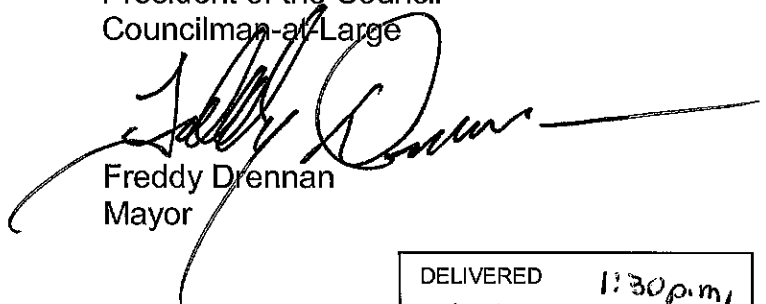
4 WHEREAS, Districts A, B, C, D, E, and G are outside the allowable +/-5%
5 deviation from the ideal district population of 3,867.
6

7 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Slidell City Council hereby
8 declares that a reapportionment of the election district boundaries must commence in
9 order to rebalance the district populations to within +/-5% of the ideal district population of
10 3,867 and that such plan, as adopted by the Council, be submitted to the U.S. Department
11 of Justice for Section 5 Pre-Clearance and the State of Louisiana no later than December
12 31, 2011.
