7 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell,
8 Appendix A Zoning, PART 4. OFF-STREET AUTOMOBILE PARKING AND LOADING
9 REGULATIONS to revise the parking ordinance.

10 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
11 hereby amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Appendix A Zoning, PART 4.
12 OFF-STREET AUTOMOBILE PARKING AND LOADING REGULATIONS, as follows:

14 **Section 4.1. General requirements.**

15 Delete paragraph 4.104 in its entirety and replace with the following:
16

18 4.104 In all residential zoning districts, the following applies to off-street parking of
19 Vehicles, Recreational Vehicles, Trailers, and Boats:
20

- 21 a. For purposes of this Section only, corner lot front yards are defined as any yard
22 having street frontage;
23
24 b. No Vehicle, Recreational Vehicle, Trailer, or Boat may be parked on an unpaved
25 surface in any front yard;
26
27 c. All Recreational Vehicles, Trailers, and Boats must be parked in the side or rear
28 yard when accessible. A fence is not cause to prevent access to the side or rear
29 yard.

31 d. No Recreational Vehicle, Trailer or Boat exceeding thirty two (32) feet in overall
32 length may be parked in any front yard;
