An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 11, Criminal Code, to correspond with Louisiana State Law.

WHEREAS, Judge Jim Lamz has requested that the City of Slidell Code of Ordinances regarding theft correspond with the State Statutes under Title 14: and

WHEREAS, Slidell City Code of Ordinances Sec. 11-119, theft, provides a municipal penalty when the misappropriation or taking amounts to less than a value of \$300.00; and

WHEREAS, the corresponding State Statute, La. R.S. 14:67, provides a misdemeanor theft when the misappropriation or taking amounts to less than a value of \$500.00; and

WHEREAS, Sec. 11-120, theft of goods, provides a municipal penalty when the misappropriation or taking amounts to less than a value of \$100.00; and

WHEREAS, the corresponding State Statute, La. R.S. 14:67.10, provides a misdemeanor penalty when the misappropriation or taking amounts to less than a value of \$500.00; and

WHEREAS, Judge Jim Lamz has requested the Slidell City Council increase the value of the misappropriation or taking in municipal theft and theft of goods to a value of less than \$500.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend Chapter 11, Criminal Code, as follows:

Sec. 11-119. Theft.

Delete paragraph "(b)" in its entirety and replace with the following:

"(b) Whoever commits the crime of theft when the misappropriation or taking amounts to less than a value of \$500.00 shall be subject to the penalties as provided in 11-

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend Chapter 11, Criminal Code, as follows:

Sec. 11-120. Theft of goods.

Delete paragraph "(c)" in its entirety and replace with the following:

"(c) Whoever commits the crime of theft of goods when the misappropriation or taking amounts to less than a value of \$500.00 shall be subject to the penalties as provided in 11-4."
