An ordinance to establish and implement a common radio communication system that will permit the City of Slidell, Slidell Police Department, St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office, St. Tammany Parish Government, St. Tammany Fire District(s) and other Municipal Police Departments and possibly federal agencies to communicate during a major event and authorize the Mayor to enter into and sign an Intergovernmental Agreement by and between the City of Slidell and the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office ("Agreement").

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell and Slidell Police Department are in need of an updated and more effective radio communication system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell's current radio communications lease is due to expire in 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell, Slidell Police Department, St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office, St. Tammany Parish Government, St. Tammany Fire District(s) and other Municipal Police Departments have been and remain on different communications systems; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell, Slidell Police Department, St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office, St. Tammany Parish Government, St. Tammany Fire District(s) and other Municipal Police Departments recognize and agree that there is a need to establish and implement a common radio communication system so that the Slidell Police Department, other local police, fire agencies, local government and possibly federal agencies can communicate during a major event; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell, St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office and other participating agencies recognize that the implementation of this new radio communication system requires a financial commitment from all agencies who desire to use the new radio system; and

WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office will dedicate, provide and maintain radio system capacity and utilization for 200 radio users for the City of Slidell; and

WHEREAS, the City will pay to the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office fourteen (14) annual payments each not to exceed \$154,331.42, inclusive of all maintenance costs, beginning July 1, 2015 and continuing until such time that the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office bond obligation is satisfied or July 1, 2028, whichever occurs first; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell and the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office will enter into a separate Intergovernmental Agreement within one hundred eighty (180) days following the execution of this Agreement, for the use of the City's existing radio tower and land, and maintenance of all equipment attached thereto in connection herewith, located, 2112 Sgt. Alfred Dr., Slidell, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, the parties to the Intergovernmental Agreement acknowledge and agree that the common radio communication system is vital to the safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Slidell and St. Tammany Parish.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, serving as the governing authority for the City of Slidell, authorizes the Mayor to enter into and sign the Intergovernmental Agreement by and between the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office and the City of Slidell.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED the City of Slidell, Slidell Police Department, St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office, St. Tammany Parish Government, St. Tammany Fire District(s) and other Municipal Police Departments recognize and agree that there is a need to establish and implement a common radio communication system so that the Slidell Police Department, other local police, fire agencies, local government and possibly federal agencies can communicate during a major event.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office will dedicate, provide and maintain radio system capacity and utilization for 200 radio users for the City of Slidell.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED the City will pay to the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office fourteen (14) annual payments each not to exceed \$154,331.42, inclusive of all maintenance costs, beginning July 1, 2015 and continuing until such time that the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office bond obligation is satisfied or July 1, 2028, whichever occurs first.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED the City of Slidell and the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office will enter into a separate Cooperative Endeavor Agreement, within one hundred eighty (180) days following the execution of this Agreement, for the use of the
