5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3752**

7 An ordinance relative to the local office of the Louisiana Department of Motor  
8 Vehicles.

9  
10 WHEREAS, Louisiana law provides that each Parish must have at least one  
11 Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) office; and

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13 WHEREAS, the current Slidell DMV office handles in excess of 43,000  
14 transactions per year; and

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16 WHEREAS, that office has been threatened with closure due to State budget  
17 cuts; and

18  
19 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell desires to have the Slidell DMV office remain  
20 open; and

21  
22 WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statute La.R.S. 32:429(A)(1), as amended,  
23 authorizes the governing authority of any local government to levy a fee of up to three  
24 dollars (\$3.00) for each service or transaction carried out as an operation of a DMV office  
25 that is not fully funded by the State; and

26  
27 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell desires to levy a fee of three dollars and no/100  
28 (\$3.00) for each service or transaction carried out as an operation of the Slidell DMV  
29 Office.

30  
31 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that a fee of  
32 three dollars and no/100 (\$3.00) is hereby levied on each service or transaction carried out  
33 as an operation by the Slidell DMV office to be used solely to defray the cost of operations


4 of the Slidell DMV office including, but not limited to, facility rental, utilities, and  
5 maintenance.  
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7 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the transaction fee shall be collected  
8  
9 beginning January 1, 2015; and


10 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute

12 any documents necessary to carry out this ordinance.
