ORDINANCE NO. 3759

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Appendix A, Zoning, Part 2. Schedule of District Regulations Adopted, Sec. 2.7 A-4 transitional district.

WHEREAS, A-4 transitional district zoning is intended to provide a less intense use buffer between commercial and residential lots; and

WHEREAS, the core of A-4 transitional district zoning permitted use is offices, personal service shops, and artist and photographic studios, which generally do not operate at night, conducts all activity indoors, and generates less automobile traffic than commercial use.

WHEREAS, A-4 transitional district zoning has less impact on residences and can provide a buffer space between residences and 24 hour commercial operations; and

WHEREAS, A-4 transitional district zoning permits multi-family residential, which is inconsistent with the district's purpose of providing a buffer between residential and commercial uses; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it hereby amends the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Appendix A, Zoning, Part 2. Schedule of District Regulations Adopted, Sec. 2.7 A-4 transitional district by removing multi-family residential as a permitted use.
