20 respective age and condition cannot serve a public purpose and therefore, are no longer
21 needed for a public purpose and declared surplus; the disposition of same shall be
22 pursuant to Louisiana Constitution, Article VII, Section 14(E) and Revised Statute
23 33:4712(F):
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
