5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3762**

7 An ordinance authorizing the rental of up to ten (10) parking space locations
8 located at the northeast section of the parking lot at Textron to Acadian Ambulance
9 Service, Inc. to facilitate the parking for Acadian employees and occasionally the parking
10 of emergency ambulance/vehicles for a fee; and further, authorizing the Mayor to enter into
11 and sign an Agreement By and Between City of Slidell ("City") and Acadian Ambulance
12 Service, Inc. ("Acadian").

13 WHEREAS, City owns certain property throughout the City of Slidell; and

14 WHEREAS, City utilizes certain City property for the purpose of parking City
15 vehicles and employee parking; and

16 WHEREAS, Acadian has contracted with the City to provide ambulance
17 services to its citizens; and

18 WHEREAS, City and Acadian have determined that the interest of Slidell
19 citizens would benefit by providing parking spaces to Acadian employees in order to
20 facilitate a smooth and timely transition for said employees in maintaining a timely and
21 efficient schedule; and

22 WHEREAS, Acadian desires to rent up to ten (10) parking spaces per month
23 from the City; and

24 WHEREAS, City desires to rent stated parking spaces to Acadian; and

25 WHEREAS, City has identified ten (10) parking spaces at the northeast
26 section of the parking lot at Textron to facilitate the parking for Acadian employees and
27 occasionally the parking of an emergency ambulance/vehicle; and

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4 WHEREAS, City will make available ten (10) parking spaces to Acadian and
5 will also make and install two "Reserved Parking" signs to be affixed thereon identifying
6 said spaces; and
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9 WHEREAS, Acadian agrees to pay the City the sum of Fifty Dollars and
10 no/100
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12 (\$ 50.00) for said signs; and
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14 WHEREAS, Acadian agrees to pay the City the sum of Thirty Dollars and
15 no/100
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17 (\$ 30.00) per parking space per month up to a total of ten (10) parking spaces for a
18 maximum fee of Three Hundred Dollars and no/100 (\$ 300.00) per month; and
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20 WHEREAS, the Agreement will be effective retroactively to January 5, 2015
21 and extend for a minimum period of six months but not to exceed a period of twelve
22 months; City and Acadian have an option to extend this Agreement for two additional six
23 month periods by mutual written agreement; and
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27 WHEREAS, Acadian and its employees agree to obtain and maintain all
28 insurance coverage's necessary to protect their property, as well as, damages/injuries that
29 may be caused to others by Acadian personnel; and
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32 WHEREAS, Acadian agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City from
33 any cause of action arising from the negligence of Acadian and/or its employees.
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35 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does
36 hereby authorize the rental of up to ten (10) parking space locations located at the
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4 northeast section of the parking lot at Textron to Acadian Ambulance Service, Inc. to
5 facilitate the parking for Acadian employees and occasionally the parking of emergency
6 ambulance/vehicles for a monthly fee per parking space and in accordance with the terms
7 and conditions set out in the Agreement By and Between City of Slidell and Acadian
8
9 Ambulance Service, Inc.;


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12 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance is effective upon adoption
13 and the Agreement By and Between City of Slidell and Acadian Ambulance Service, Inc.
14 shall be effective retroactively to January 1, 2015;

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17 BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that Mayor Freddy Drennan is hereby authorized
18 to execute any documents necessary to carry out this Ordinance including, but not limited
19 to, the Agreement attached hereto and made a part hereof.
