8 An ordinance amending the code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter
9 23 Solid Waste, Sec. 23-13 Storage locations of dumpsters and trash receptacles.

10 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, that
11 Chapter 23 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Solid Waste, Sec. 23-13,
12 Paragraph (a), be deleted and replaced with the following:
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16 (a) All containers for residential solid waste, yard waste and recyclables shall be
17 stored on the premises within five (5) feet of the principal building and extending to
18 both side lot lines.

19 For this section only, the following definitions apply:


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21 Front Yard - being that part of a lot between the front lot line and the front of the
22 principal building on the lot extending to both sides of the lot.

23 Principal Building - Any structure designed or built or used for the support,
24 enclosure, shelter or protection of persons, animals, chattels or property of any
25 kind. The extension of the principal building by a garage under roof and/or a
26 carport attached to the principal building shall serve to extend the Principal Building
27 to the furthest point of said attached structure.

28 *Nothing herein is intended to serve nor does it serve as an exception to or waiver
29 of all other zoning regulations including, but not limited to, front yard setbacks.
