5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3823**

7 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell,
8 Chapter 28 Utilities, Section 28-130(c)(2)(c) requiring grease traps in multi-family dwelling
9 units.

10
11 WHEREAS, Ordinance Section 28-130(c)(2)(c) currently exempts private
12 living quarters or dwelling units from the grease trap requirement; and
13

14 WHEREAS, the City's Public Operations Department has reported that
15 grease from multi-family dwelling units is detrimental to the City's sewerage system; and
16

17 WHEREAS, the City's Public Operations Department recommends that
18 grease traps be required for multi-family dwelling units which units are four-plexes or
19 larger; and

22 WHEREAS, the City desires to allow compliance with this grease trap
23 requirement over an approximate six month period.

26 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the
27 Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 28 Utilities, Section 28-130(c)(2)(c) is
28 hereby deleted and replaced with the following:
29

30 "Grease, oil and sand interceptors shall be provided when they are
31 necessary for the proper handling of wastewater containing free or emulsified
32 oil and/or grease exceeding 100 mg/l, or any flammable wastes, or other
33 harmful ingredient except that such interceptors shall not be required for
34 dwelling units smaller than a four-plex. All interceptors shall be of a type and
35 capacity approved by the City and shall be located so as to be readily and
36 easily accessible for cleaning and inspection."
