5 **ORDINANCE NO. 3848**

7 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter  
8 6, Animals.

9  
10 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does  
11 hereby amend the Code of Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Chapter 6, Animals, as follows:

12  
13 Sec. 6-1: Definitions, amend the definition of "*Animal establishment*" to delete  
14 the words "or and private";

15  
16 Sec. 6-1 Definitions, amend the definition of "*Nuisance*" to delete the words  
17 "or noise making defined as continuous barking for 15 minutes";

18  
19 Sec. 6-1 Definitions, delete the words "*Private kennel*" and the entire  
20 definition;

21  
22 Sec. 6-1 Definitions, delete the words "*Private owner*" and the entire  
23 definition;

24  
25 Sec. 6-27(e): delete the second sentence which begins with "A fee free  
26 permit...";

27  
28 Sec. 6-29 Owner responsibility, add a new subsection 6-29(j) to read "It shall  
29 be unlawful for any person to own or maintain more than six domestic animals over the  
30 age of four months on private residential property within the city limits."

31  
32 Sec. 36(b): Delete entire subsection. The remaining subsections will have to  
33 be re-designated appropriately;

34  
35 Sec. 36(h): Replace "ten" with "five";

36  
37 Sec. 36(i): Replace "ten-day" with "five-day";

38  
39 Sec. 6-113: Delete "and private kennels" from the title;

40  
41 Sec. 6-113(e): In the last sentence delete "for euthanasia immediately" and  
42 replace with "to Animal Control immediately.";

4           Sec. 6-113(h): Replace the first sentence with the following language: "It  
5 shall be unlawful to leave or confine an animal in any unattended motor vehicle under  
6 conditions that endanger the health or wellbeing of an animal due to heat, cold, lack of  
7 food, or lack of water that could reasonably be expected to cause suffering, disability, or  
8 death to the animal."  
9

10           Sec. 6-113(l): Delete entire subsection;

11  
12           Sec. 6-113(m): Delete entire subsection. Re-designate the remaining  
13 subsection (n) as (l).

14           BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that this ordinance will become effective upon  
15 adoption.
