ORDINANCE NO. 3850

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Slidell to enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement and Lease with the Lakeside Swim Club Corporation for the property and facilities located at 497 Cumberland Dr., Slidell, Louisiana.

WHEREAS, Louisiana Constitution Article 7, Section 14, provides for cooperative endeavors between governmental entities and private persons for a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, City owns a certain parcel of property that includes a swimming pool and several buildings, which previously operated as a swim club known as the Hurricane Swim Club, located in the City of Slidell, Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, in Section 41 Township 9 South, Range 14 East, Ninth Ward, City of Slidell, in the Subdivision known as Westchester Estates; with the municipal address: 497 Cumberland Dr., Slidell, Louisiana ("Facility"); and

WHEREAS, City has determined that the parcel of property described above is not needed for a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, Lakeside is a non-profit organization which desires to enter into a cooperative endeavor agreement with the City of Slidell to manage, supervise, operate and maintain the pool, buildings and property located at the Facility for a ten (10) year period with two (2) five year extensions subject to the terms set out in the lease document attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

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WHEREAS, City has determined an annual rental rate of Twelve Dollars (\$ 12.00), in accordance with the Louisiana Constitution, Louisiana Statutes and Slidell City Ordinances due and payable in full upon execution of the Lease and on the anniversary date of lease entered into by the Parties and every year thereafter; and

WHEREAS, Lakeside is dedicated to developing and teaching the sport of swimming and facilitating access to recreational swimming in the Slidell area; and

WHEREAS, Lakeside is engaged in scheduling and coordinating several local schools, clubs and teams in swimming competition in the Slidell area; and

WHEREAS, Lakeside shall have authority to enter into contracts as it determines to be in the best interest of the citizens of Slidell and Lakeside, without approval from the City, subject to each contract containing a specific Hold Harmless/Indemnification Agreement in favor of the City of Slidell by all contracting parties; and

WHEREAS, Lakeside shall not sublease, assign or otherwise pledge this Agreement nor the property identified herein above for any reason whatsoever; and

WHEREAS, Lakeside desires and is committed to develop scheduling for any and all Slidell citizens to enjoy recreational swimming at this facility; and

WHEREAS, Lakeside shall assume and be fully and solely responsible for the maintenance of the pool, buildings, equipment and grounds; and

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WHEREAS, Lakeside shall be fully and solely responsible to establish the proper staff to ensure the safety of all participants utilizing the pool, buildings and/or grounds; and

WHEREAS, Lakeside shall be fully and solely responsible for all payroll taxes, benefits, and workers compensation insurance for its employees and shall provide insurance to cover any and all contractors and/or volunteers working or volunteering at the Facility; and,

WHEREAS, Lakeside herein represents the following:

- Lakeside shall make any and all repairs in order to maintain the pool, buildings and grounds.
- 2. Lakeside shall be solely responsible for all cost of existing and/or additional parking spaces, which must comply with City Ordinances.
- 3. The anticipated expenses necessary to operate and maintain the Facility, including but not limited to salaries, dues, supplies, pool chemicals, and insurance is Thirty Three Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$ 33,250.00) annually or Twenty Seven Hundred Seventy Dollars and 83/100 (\$ 2,770.83) per month.
- 4. It is anticipated that Lakeside will identify, utilize and benefit from approximately Sixteen Hundred Thirty Seven (1,637) volunteer hours to man the events presently scheduled and anticipated. The hourly value of volunteer hours varies by responsibility of task assigned to volunteer. In an effort to quantify the annual and monthly value an average amount of Ten (\$ 10.00) per hour was applied for the purposes of evaluation or Sixteen Thousand Three Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$16,364.17) annually or Thirteen Hundred Sixty Four Dollars and 17/100 (\$ 1,364.17) per month.

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- 5. The Facility will be opened and available to anyone from the general public desiring to swim with a membership or simply pay for a one day swim outing. It is anticipated that the rates, once established, will be very reasonable for families and individuals.
 - 6. The Facility will be open and free for the general public on Memorial Day, July 4th, and Labor Day.
 - Lakeside is presently in discussions with a non-profit group to facilitate the teaching of children with special needs how to swim. Lakeside strongly desires to facilitate such a program.
 - 8. Lakeside desires and anticipate that it will approach the City in the future to purchase the Facility.

WHEREAS, Lakeside acknowledges, agrees and understands that the City is not responsible for nor is the City contributing any financial assistance in connection with this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Lakeside acknowledges, agrees and understands that should the organization lose its non-profit status or change its mission to assist the citizens of Slidell, it will immediately notify the Chief Administrative Officer of said event; and

WHEREAS, City has received and reviewed the information requested and produced by Lakeside and has determined that the City will receive actual, quantifiable benefits from the activities carried out at the Facility: and

WHEREAS, City and Lakeside will benefit from their respective obligations under this Agreement and that same are at least commensurate with the respective benefits conferred.

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NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, that it does hereby authorize the Mayor of the City of Slidell to enter into and execute a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement and Lease with Lakeside Swim Club Corporation in accordance the terms set out therein and in connection therewith, of the following described property:

A certain parcel of property that includes a swimming pool, several buildings, and a parking lot located in the City of Slidell, Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, in Section 41 Township 9 South, Range 14 East, Ninth Ward, City of Slidell, in the Subdivision known as Westchester Estates; with the municipal address: 497 Cumberland Dr., Slidell, Louisiana ("Facility").
