12 hereof, is no longer needed by the City of Slidell for public use and is hereby declared
13 surplus.
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16 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the date, time, and place of sale are to be
17 fixed by the Mayor of Slidell, who shall also establish method of payment and other
18 specifications for bidders, including deadline for removal.
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21 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that surplus Police Department vehicles may
22 be subject to sale by auction to other law enforcement agencies or political subdivisions at
23 a time, date and place determined by the Mayor or his designee who shall also establish
24 method of payment and other requirements for bidders including deadline for removal.
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27 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor of the City of Slidell is authorized
28 to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the above.
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6 BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that this ordinance shall be effective upon
7 adoption.
