WHEREAS, acquisition of said Property serves the public purpose of providing the City of Slidell Recreation Department with additional land; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has allocated funds sufficient to accommodate the purchase of the Property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorizes the Mayor to execute all related real estate closing documents to conclude the purchase of said Property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby authorize the Mayor of the City of Slidell to execute all related real estate closing
